1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Don Bosco School, Itanagar, is a private Catholic educational Institution run by the Salesians of Don Bosco, according to the principles and methods of the great educator Don Bosco, which is based on reason, religion and kindness.

The school aims at the education of the Catholic community around, but extends its service to members of other communities to the extent possible.

The medium of instruction and communication in the school will always be English.

From 2005, the school has been affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi and has been preparing students for the Secondary School Examination of the Board (AISSE).

From 2011, the school has been upgraded to a Higher Secondary School with Humanities and Commerce (the school will open the science stream if permission is granted from 2021-22 session onwards).

2. AIM OF THE INSTITUTION

The aim of the institution is to impart holistic education (religious, moral, psychological, social, intellectual and physical). Ample opportunities are provided to the students through various activities like house system, competitions, games and sports, exposure to programmes outside the school, computer education, leadership training, motivational talks, scouts and guides, experience of team work. Special attention is given to ensure profound morality, discipline and character formation in the school.

3. ADMISSION

New Admission is normally open only for classes Nursery and Class XI. Admission to lower classes (KG upto VII) will depend upon the vacancies. No admission will be given to Classes VIII, IX, X and XII. Before the admissions, there will be a written test and an interview. Those shortlisted from the written test will appear for the interview. The admissions will depend on the result of the test and interview.

Admissions are made on the receipt of the following documents:

- Transfer Certificate from the institution previously attended.
- Duly filled-in application form of the school.
- The mark sheet of the last annual examination taken.

New pupils must be introduced personally by the parents/guardians who are directly responsible for the students.
